British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) Order G-97-24 - Notice Confirmation

On February 29, 2024, FBC filed the Application referenced above. On March 28, 2024, the BCUC issued Order G-97-24 establishing a regulatory timetable for review of the Application, directing FBC to provide notice as follows: provide a copy of the Application and order to various parties, make the Application and order available on its website, and post information regarding the public notice on social media platforms. On April 5, 2024, the BCUC issued an amended timetable by Order G-100-24 adjusting the deadline for FBC to provide notice of the Application and order by April 9, 2024.
