Revised Redacted Application Timing

In Order G-80-21, issued yesterday, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) suspended the regulatory timetable established by Order G-26-21, pending further process to address confidentiality.

FEI is writing to advise that since the Workshop it has been undertaking a review of the Application redactions, having regard to the Panel's comments. Although that work is still underway, FEI can confirm that it will be eliminating the redactions in a number of places so as to make more of the information public. There will continue to be some redacted information that is commercially or security-sensitive, and in those cases FEI will provide further explanation.

Next week, FEI will be filing a revised redacted version of the Application. FEI respectfully suggests that it may be most efficient for the BCUC to await that filing before determining the next steps, which would allow the process to be tailored to reflect the scope of the remaining issues.
