On March 3, 2022, FEI filed the Application requesting approval from the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC), pursuant to sections 58 to 61 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) of an updated COC and TPP effective April 1, 2022.

- A. On March 3, 2022, FortisBC Energy Inc.
