FEI Reply Submission on Written Argument Timetable

FEI writes in response to BCUC letter dated May 30, 2022¹ wherein the BCUC approved FEI's request for a one-week extension to file its responses to information requests (IRs) on its rebuttal evidence. In the letter, the BCUC also requested FEI provide a reply submission on the timing for written final argument taking into consideration the letter filed by counsel for the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality (FNDCC) and Fort Nelson & District Chamber of Commerce (NRRM)² identifying scheduling conflicts.

FEI has been able to expedite its responses to the IRs on rebuttal evidence in an effort to allow the completion of the proceeding as soon as possible. Counsel for FEI discussed timing for written final arguments with counsel for FNDCC-NRRM and came to agreement that if the IR responses on rebuttal evidence were filed by June 1, 2022, and FEI's Final Argument on June 10, then FNDCC-NRRM would be able to submit their intervener written final argument by June 30. As such, FEI proposes the following timetable for the written argument phase in this proceeding. FEI confirms that counsel for FNDCC-NRRM has agreed to this schedule.
