The Agreement does not alter the Crown's duty to consult with TWN regarding the TLSE Project, including with respect to the approval sought as part of this proceeding. As explained in the response to TWN IR2 13.1, the role of the BCUC in CPCN proceedings with respect to consultation is to assess the adequacy of FEI's consultation to date, given the nature of the approval sought.

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
