6 and Resilient Saanich (“Climate Plan”). This Climate Plan sets a vision and targets
7 to reduce community-wide GHG emissions by 50% from 2007 levels by 2030 and
8 to net zero by 2050, transition to 100% renewable energy by 2050 and prepare for
9 a changing climate².
