**Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for the
Okanagan Capacity Mitigation Project (OCMP or Project) (Application)
Amendment to Communication Activities Update**

On December 2, 2024, FEI filed its update on consultation and communication activities regarding the OCMP with the BCUC. FEI would like to advise the BCUC of an inaccuracy that has just come to FEI's attention in relation to the paid media advertisements described in row 3 of Appendix B. The print advertisements that were to have been placed in the Kelowna Capital News and the Kelowna Daily Courier newspapers did not occur due to an administrative error on the part of FEI's media booking contractor.

In the course of its requests for newspaper publications, FEI requires copies of the published advertisements as proof of publication (referred to as "tear sheets"). FEI's media booking contractor was unable to provide the tear sheets related to these print advertisements scheduled for the OCMP. Upon further investigation, FEI's media booking contractor has confirmed that the newspapers did not receive the booking requests or the advertisements for publication. The media booking contractor has since advised that they experienced an internal system software issue that resulted in the newspaper publications not taking place.

FEI confirms that the other communication activities identified in Appendix B, including the digital advertisements described in row 3 of Appendix B, were completed as reported. As a result, FEI has amended Appendix B and attached the amended version to this letter for the record.
