**ORDER**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On July 20, 2023, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC), pursuant to sections 58 to 61 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, its 2023 Cost of Service Allocation (COSA) study and application for approval of revenue rebalancing, effective January 1, 2025 (Application);
- B. By Order G-144-24, the BCUC made its final determinations on the Application (COSA Decision) and directed FEI to implement the resulting rate changes to its rate schedules, effective January 1, 2025. Directive 2 of the same order established the deadline for FEI to file revised tariff pages with the BCUC for endorsement within 60 days of the date of the order;
- C. FEI requests that Directive 2 of Order G-144-24 be varied, given that there will likely be other changes to its tariff pages prior to January 1, 2025; and
- D. The BCUC determines that a variation of Directive 2 of Order G-144-24 is warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to section 99 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the BCUC orders that Directive 2 of Order G-144-24 is varied as follows:

FEI is directed to file revised tariff pages reflecting the COSA Decision with the BCUC for endorsement at the same time FEI files tariff pages for any general delivery charge or commodity rate changes effective January 1, 2025, by no later than December 15, 2024.
