**ORDER**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On August 4, 2021, FortisBC Inc. (FBC) filed its 2021 Long-Term Electric Resource Plan (2021 LTERP) including its 2021 Long-Term Demand-Side Management (DSM) Plan (2021 LT DSM Plan) for acceptance by the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) pursuant to section 44.1(6) of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) (Application);
- B. By Order G-265-21, dated September 9, 2021, and as amended by Orders G-292-21, G-314-21, G-24-22 and G-130-33, the BCUC established a public hearing and regulatory timetable, including intervenor registration, two rounds of information requests (IRs), filing of intervenor evidence, IRs on intervenor evidence, filing of rebuttal evidence, IRs on rebuttal evidence, Panel IRs and final and reply arguments;
- C. On July 6, 2022, FBC filed a separate application for BCUC approval of a large commercial interruptible rate which is pending review by another panel. That application includes references by FBC to a request for approval of the Clean Market Adder as part of its request for acceptance of the 2021 LTERP in this proceeding; and
- D. In light of the evidence filed to date in this proceeding and the filing of the subsequent application and the statements made by FBC in that application, the BCUC determines that the establishment of a further regulatory timetable is warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE** the BCUC establishes a further regulatory timetable as set out in Appendix A to this order.
