ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On December 9, 2020, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) pursuant to section 23(1)(g) of the Utilities Commission Act for approval of an operating agreement, dated December 4, 2020, entered into between the Corporation of the City of Nelson (City of Nelson) and FEI, effective March 1, 2021 (FEI-Nelson Operating Agreement) (Application);
- B. FEI, through its predecessor companies Inland Natural Gas Co. Ltd. and Terasen Gas Inc., and the City of Nelson entered into a franchise agreement approved by BCUC Order C-16-80 dated June 12, 1980, and later a franchise amendment agreement approved by BCUC Order C-3-04, dated May 13, 2004. The franchise amendment agreement expires on February 28, 2021;
- C. By Order G-5-21, dated January 8, 2021, the BCUC established a public hearing process for the review of the Application, which included public notice and intervener registration and letters of comment by a deadline of February 11, 2021. No requests to intervene or letters of comment were received by the BCUC by the deadline; and
- D. The BCUC has reviewed the Application and determines that approval is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 23(1)(g) of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the BCUC orders that the FEI-Nelson Operating Agreement is approved on a permanent basis, effective March 1, 2021.
