Thinking about renovating your home? Valuable rebates help you save on a variety of energy-efficiency upgrades.





Four steps to participate

1) Learn more online

- Visit **fortisbc.com/homerebates** for a list of all the rebate eligible upgrades and bonus offers. From here you can select the individual upgrade webpages to find more details.
- 2) Decide what's right for your home and budget
- Choose eligible upgrades and apply for individual rebates on your own.
 - OR -
- Get professional advice and access to additional rebates by hiring program-qualified energy advisor (PQEA).
- 3) Have a contractor install eligible upgrades

To be eligible for rebates you must hire a qualified contractor to complete all your upgrades.
