

Notice: EPSQ Rules in WINS

September 28, 2015

This notice is to advise that the elapsed pro-rata scheduled quantities (or EPSQ) rules are not calculating accurately in WINS. In light of this, if you are adjusting your nominations in the Intra-day, please align your WINS nomination in accordance with Spectra's EPSQ limits.

EPSQ rules is a NAESB standard for nomination reduction limits based on the gas that has flowed (scheduled) at a given time/cycle within the gas day.

For **Timely and Evening cycles**, a nominated volume can be reduced down to zero with no issues of EPSQ.

For the **ID1 cycle**, the nomination may only be reduced by 2/3 of its scheduled volume at Evening.

For the **ID2 cycle**, the nomination may only be reduced by 1/2 of its scheduled volume at ID1.

For nominations placed at the ID1 cycle (with no nominations placed at Timely or Evening), the nomination at ID2 can be reduced to a minimum of 1/4 of the scheduled volume of ID1.
