

## Notice: Hold to Authorize – Lower Mainland, Interior, & Columbia

## HOLD TO AUTHORIZE for Lower Mainland (incl. Vancouver Island), Interior, & Columbia effective December 24, 2021

Due to cold weather, a <u>Hold to Authorize</u> will be in effect and <u>Imbalance Return</u> will be <u>reduced to</u> <u>zero</u> for the <u>Lower Mainland</u>, <u>Interior</u>, and <u>Columbia regions effective Friday</u>, <u>December 24</u>, <u>2021</u> until further notice.

When Imbalance Return is zero, this means that Shippers cannot use their inventory as a source of supply. With the Hold to Authorize restriction at the Lower Mainland and Interior, if a Shipper or Group, as applicable, takes Unauthorized Overrun Gas (i.e., Gas in excess of the amount specified above), then unauthorized overrun charges will apply per the applicable Rate Schedule. Specifically, the first 5% will be charged at the Sumas Daily Price. Gas taken in excess of 5% will be charged the greater of CAD \$20.00 per gigajoule or the Sumas Daily Price times 1.5.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
