

Notice: Imbalance Return and Hold to Authorize

February 7, 2021

Operation changes for the Lower Mainland (including Vancouver Island), Interior and Columbia regions:

Effective Tuesday, February 9 Imbalance return is reduced to zero and a Hold to Authorize restriction will be in place until further notice.

Based on the forecast, customers on interruptible rate schedules may be curtailed as of Wednesday, February 10. Those customers will be notified directly if this restriction is required.

When Imbalance Return is zero, this means that Shippers cannot use their inventory as a source of supply. With the Hold to Authorize restriction, if a Shipper or Group, as applicable, takes Unauthorized Overrun Gas (i.e., Gas in excess of the amount specified above), then unauthorized overrun charges will apply per the applicable Rate Schedule. Specifically, the first 5% will be charged at the Sumas Daily Price. Gas taken in excess of 5% will be charged the greater of CAD \$20.00 per gigajoule or the Sumas Daily Price times 1.5.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
