

## Notice: Hold to Authorize – Lower Mainland and Interior

February 4, 2019

## HOLD TO AUTHORIZE for the Lower Mainland and Interior effective February 6, 2019

Effective <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>February 6</u>, until further notice, a <u>Hold to Authorize</u> will be in effect for the <u>Lower</u> Mainland and Interior.

<u>Imbalance Return</u> for the <u>Lower Mainland and Interior</u> will <u>remain at ZERO</u> until further notice.

When Imbalance Return is zero, this means that Shippers cannot use their inventory as a source of supply. With the Hold to Authorize restriction at the Lower Mainland and Interior, if a Shipper or Group, as applicable, takes Unauthorized Overrun Gas (i.e., Gas in excess of the amount specified above), then unauthorized overrun charges will apply per the applicable Rate Schedule. Specifically, the first 5% will be charged at the Sumas Daily Price. Gas taken in excess of 5% will be charged the greater of CAD \$20.00 per gigajoule or the Sumas Daily Price times 1.5.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
