

## Imbalance Return to Zero

January 30, 2025

Based on the weather forecast and expectation of extended cold weather, effective Saturday, February 1, Imbalance Return will be reduced to zero across all service areas in the province. This restriction will remain in effect until further notice.

Please be prepared to make the necessary arrangements on behalf of your customers to ensure you have sufficient supply to meet anticipated demand.

As a reminder, Balancing Premium Surcharges for drafting within the tolerance levels are as follows:

Tolerance Range	Charge per GJ
0-10%	No charge
10%-20%	\$0.25 (annual)
20% plus	\$0.30 (summer) and \$1.10 (winter)

We encourage everyone to monitor Environment Canada for updates.

FortisBC Energy will continue to monitor the forecast and will communicate any further operational changes, if and as needed.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC continues to monitor the weather and operational conditions across its service regions and will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
