

Critical Notice impacting Interior Shipper Business

April 27, 2023

FortisBC's summer maintenance program has begun for our Interior system which will result in system pressure restrictions. As a result, effective May 1st until further notice, Interior Shippers must exercise extra due diligence to match their supply with anticipated customer demand. As usual, Shippers should reach out to their customers directly to determine changes to daily supply requirements.

Shippers must not pack their Interior accounts. For those with an existing pack please bring your imbalance down immediately.

FEI will be monitoring Shipper imbalances on a daily basis to ensure compliance. If necessary, FEI will cut business as needed to prevent excess inventory.

Please note, customers in Lower Mainland, Vancouver Island, Columbia and East Kootenay regions are unaffected by this restriction. Shippers must continue their oversight to ensure group imbalances do not exceed the required 2-3 day pack by location.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC continues to monitor the weather and operational conditions across its service regions and will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
