As indicated in the FortisBC notice issued yesterday January 9, transportation customers across all service areas in the province will be in a Hold to Authorize restriction with Imbalance Return at zero starting January 11 until further notice.

Be advised that based on the forecasted temperatures for Friday, January 12, Interruptible customers under Rate Schedules 7, 22, and 27 in the Lower Mainland and Vancouver Island service areas will likely be curtailed. In preparation and anticipation of this curtailment, an advisory has already been sent directly to customers.

FEI will issue another notice tomorrow morning advising if the curtailment is required based on updated weather forecasts.

We encourage everyone to monitor Environment Canada for updates.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC continues to monitor the weather and operational conditions across its service regions and will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
