

Operational Update: Current Restrictions on FortisBC

Operational Update:

Please be advised that FortisBC is actively monitoring the weather as well as capacity restrictions on Westcoast. It is our intention to lift Hold to Authorize and release half of Imbalance Return for January 1 provided that Westcoast T-South authorization is maintained at 100%. See Westcoast's Notice #55377. We will issue a follow-up notice advising of operational changes prior to the start of January 1, 2022.

Capacity Curtailment Lifted:

As indicated in the email earlier today at 11:15AM PST, effective Thursday, December 30th at 7AM PST, Interruptible customers under Rate Schedules 7, 22, and 27 in Lower Mainland are no longer under a curtailment restriction.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC continues to monitor the weather and operational conditions across its service regions and will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
