
Summer 2025 Tolerances

March 31, 2025

During the upcoming summer months, FEI requests that all shippers hold an imbalance no greater than one day based on the average daily load of the customer group. This tolerance applies to all service areas including the Lower Mainland, Interior, Columbia, and East Kootenay.

This tolerance change is due to tighter tolerances and balancing requirements on Westcoast which have increased over time, as well as the more common occurrence of high linepack on both Enbridge and NWP systems. As FEI holds the OBA at each interconnect location and is required to trend to zero each and every day, it is imperative that all shippers contributing to system imbalances reduce their total system imbalance to no greater than one day of daily average load.

We will reevaluate this tolerance as we approach winter.
