

2026 Summer Tolerance Requirement

April 22, 2026

During the summer months, all shippers are required to hold an imbalance no greater than one day based on the average daily load of the customer group. This tolerance applies to all service areas including the Lower Mainland (including Vancouver Island), Interior, Columbia, and East Kootenay.

This requirement is due to tighter tolerances and balancing requirements on Westcoast which have increased over time, reduced capacity due to pipeline maintenance, and the more common occurrence of high linepack on both Enbridge and NWP systems. As FEI holds the OBA at each interconnect location and is required to trend to zero each and every day, it is imperative that all shippers contributing to system imbalances reduce their cumulative imbalance to no greater than one day of daily average load.

Please review your imbalances in each service area and take steps to reduce as necessary.
