

Important Notice: Imbalance Return & Hold to Authorize

January 9, 2020

Due to the upcoming cold weather, the following operational changes for the **Lower Mainland, Interior and Columbia regions** will come into effect:

EFFECTIVE SUNDAY, JANUARY 12

• Imbalance Return at the Lower Mainland, Interior and Columbia regions will be reduced by half *This means on Sunday, January 12 the allocated amount for each group will be half of what you are currently receiving.*

EFFECTIVE MONDAY, JANUARY 13

- Imbalance Return at the Lower Mainland, Interior and Columbia regions will be reduced to ZERO
- Hold to Authorize will be in effect for the Lower Mainland, Interior and Columbia regions
- Be advised the above two restrictions will remain in place until further notice

With the Hold to Authorize restriction at the Lower Mainland, Interior and Columbia regions, if a Shipper or Group, as applicable, takes Unauthorized Overrun Gas (i.e., Gas in excess of the amount specified above), then unauthorized overrun charges will apply per the applicable Rate Schedule. Specifically, the first 5% will be charged at the Sumas Daily Price. Gas taken in excess of 5% will be charged the greater of CAD \$20.00 per gigajoule or the Sumas Daily Price times 1.5.

FEI reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FEI will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
