

## Notice: Imbalance Return Eliminated – Lower Mainland

November 14, 2018

## **Operational Changes for the Lower Mainland:**

Effective Friday, November 16 until further notice, Imbalance Return in the Lower Mainland will be reduced to zero. The Hold to Authorize will <u>remain in effect</u> at the Lower Mainland as it is today until further notice.

If a Shipper or Group, as applicable, takes Unauthorized Overrun Gas (i.e., Gas in excess of the amount specified above), then unauthorized overrun charges will apply per the applicable Rate Schedule. Specifically, the first 5% will be charged at the Sumas Daily Price. Gas taken in excess of 5% will be charged the greater of CAD \$20.00 per gigajoule or the Sumas Daily Price times 1.5.

## No Operational Changes for the Interior:

The Hold to Authorize remains <u>lifted</u> in the Interior effective November 6 to present until further notice. Also effective November 6 until further notice, 40,000GJ of Imbalance Return is available. Each applicable Shipper will receive an allocated volume of Imbalance Return based on their percentage load at this location. You can view your allocated amount in your Inventory report for your Daily Interior group from November 6 to present.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
