

## Notice: Operational Changes for Imbalance Return

December 5, 2018

## **Operational Changes for the Lower Mainland:**

Effective Friday, December 7, until further notice Imbalance Return in the Lower Mainland will be reduced to 20,000GJ.

The Hold to Authorize will <u>remain in effect</u> at the Lower Mainland as it is today until further notice. This means your group of customers must balance within a <u>5% tolerance</u>.

If a Shipper or Group, as applicable, takes Unauthorized Overrun Gas (i.e., Gas in excess of the amount specified above), then unauthorized overrun charges will apply per the applicable Rate Schedule. Specifically, the first 5% will be charged at the Sumas Daily Price. Gas taken in excess of 5% will be charged the greater of CAD \$20.00 per gigajoule or the Sumas Daily Price times 1.5.

## **Operational Changes for the Interior:**

Also effective Friday, December 7, until further notice Imbalance Return in the Interior will be reduced to 20,000GJ.

The Hold to Authorize remains <u>lifted</u> in the Interior until further notice.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
