

Important Notice: Operational Changes

November 2, 2018

Operational Changes for the Interior:

Effective Tuesday, November 6, until further notice, the Hold to Authorize restriction will be <u>lifted</u> at the Interior (Savona) location. Also effective November 6 until further notice, Imbalance Return will be set at 40,000GJ for the Interior. Be advised that operational changes on Westcoast during November may impact deliveries to both the Interior and the Lower Mainland. Should that occur, Fortis may reduce or eliminate Imbalance Return. We will provide as much notice as possible in the event this happens.

Operational Changes for the Lower Mainland:

The Hold to Authorize will <u>remain in effect</u> at the Lower Mainland as it is today until further notice. Imbalance Return will remain at the current authorized amount of 30,000GJ until further notice.

Reminder - Daily Balancing in effect

Effective November 1, 2018 all transportation customers in the <u>Lower Mainland and Interior</u> will be held to daily balancing provisions. In addition, the daily balancing tolerance has been reduced to 10%, and a new balancing charge has been approved for shortfalls within the 10% to 20% tolerance range at \$0.25 per GJ. For those with monthly balanced groups, your customers have been moved into your Daily Lower Mainland or Daily Interior groups. Please check your burn reports and Inventory reports.

For Rate Schedule 22B customers located in the Columbia region, daily balancing provisions will apply effective November 1, 2019.

FortisBC reserves the right to limit the use of imbalance return or otherwise curtail service. FortisBC will provide as much advanced notice as possible in the event of changes.
