

## Notice: Critical Notice

October 10, 2018

As indicated in **Enbridge's Critical Notice (#50877)** issued last night:

BC Pipeline has experienced an interruption in service on the TSouth system.

Earlier this evening, a rupture occurred on a natural gas transmission pipeline owned and operated by Enbridge approximately 13.5 km north of Prince George, B.C.. The rupture ignited at the site which is in a rural area. There are no reports of injuries as a result of the incident.

*Enbridge emergency crews have responded, have isolated and currently depressuring two natural gas transmissions lines in the vicinity to contain the incident.* 

## Impact to Transportation Customers and Marketers on Fortis' system:

- A Force Majeure has been declared impacting all interruptible customers in the Lower Mainland, Interior and Vancouver Island
- Fortis is asking firm customers to cut back
- Imbalance return in the Lower Mainland and Interior is zero effective today until further notice
- Enbridge's authorized T-South is zero effective for October 11 gas day
