

Notice: EPSQ Rules in WINS

October 26, 2016

As a reminder, be mindful of EPSQ rules that come into play when adjusting your nominations in the Intra-day.

EPSQ rules are a NAESB standard for nomination reduction limits based on the gas that has flowed (scheduled) at a given time/cycle in the gas day.

Timely cycle: Nominations must be entered before 11:00 PST for the next day's business or subsequent days. There are no EPSQ rules for this cycle meaning a scheduled volume can be confirmed down to zero with no issues of EPSQ.

Evening cycle: Nominations must be entered before 16:00 PST for the next day's business. There are no EPSQ rules for this cycle meaning a scheduled volume can be confirmed down to zero with no issues of EPSQ.

ID1 cycle: Nominations must be entered before 8:00 PST for the current business day. Nominations can be lowered no more than 5/24 of the previously scheduled volume at the Evening cycle before encountering EPSQ limits.

ID2 cycle: Nominations must be entered before 12:30 PST for the current business day. Nominations can be lowered no more than 9/24 of the previously scheduled volumes at the Evening and ID1 cycles before encountering EPSQ limits.

ID3 cycle: Nominations must be entered before 17:00 PST for the current business day. Nominations can be lowered no more than 13/24 of the previously scheduled volumes at the Evening , ID1 and ID2 cycles before encountering EPSQ limits.
