

Notice: Hold to Authorized Advisory

December 14, 2016

As you are all aware, on December 8, 2016 FEI issued a supply restriction notice effective for <u>December 12 until further notice</u>. This restriction applies to customers in the Lower Mainland (inclusive of Vancouver Island customers pooled in Lower Mainland Groups) and customers in the Interior.

Under supply restriction circumstances, marketers managing both daily and monthly balanced groups at these locations must bring on sufficient supply <u>each and every day</u> in order to meet demand. If demand on a day is above the authorized quantity, <u>unauthorized overrun charges</u> will apply. The first 5% of gas taken over the authorized quantity will be charged to the Shipper or Group at the Sumas Daily Price. Gas taken in excess of the 5% of the authorized quantity will be charged the greater of CAD \$20.00 per gigajoule or the Sumas Daily Price times 1.5.

Reminder – use your **SCP Peaking gas and EKE Entitlement** for additional supply. If you need a reminder of your allocated amounts or how these work, please contact us via email or the Hotline.

Also please remember that *if* UOR charges are incurred, keep in mind that during the month these charges are based on metered non-billable data or in some cases, estimated data. When the measurement data is finalized at month end, UOR charges will be recalculated at that time.
